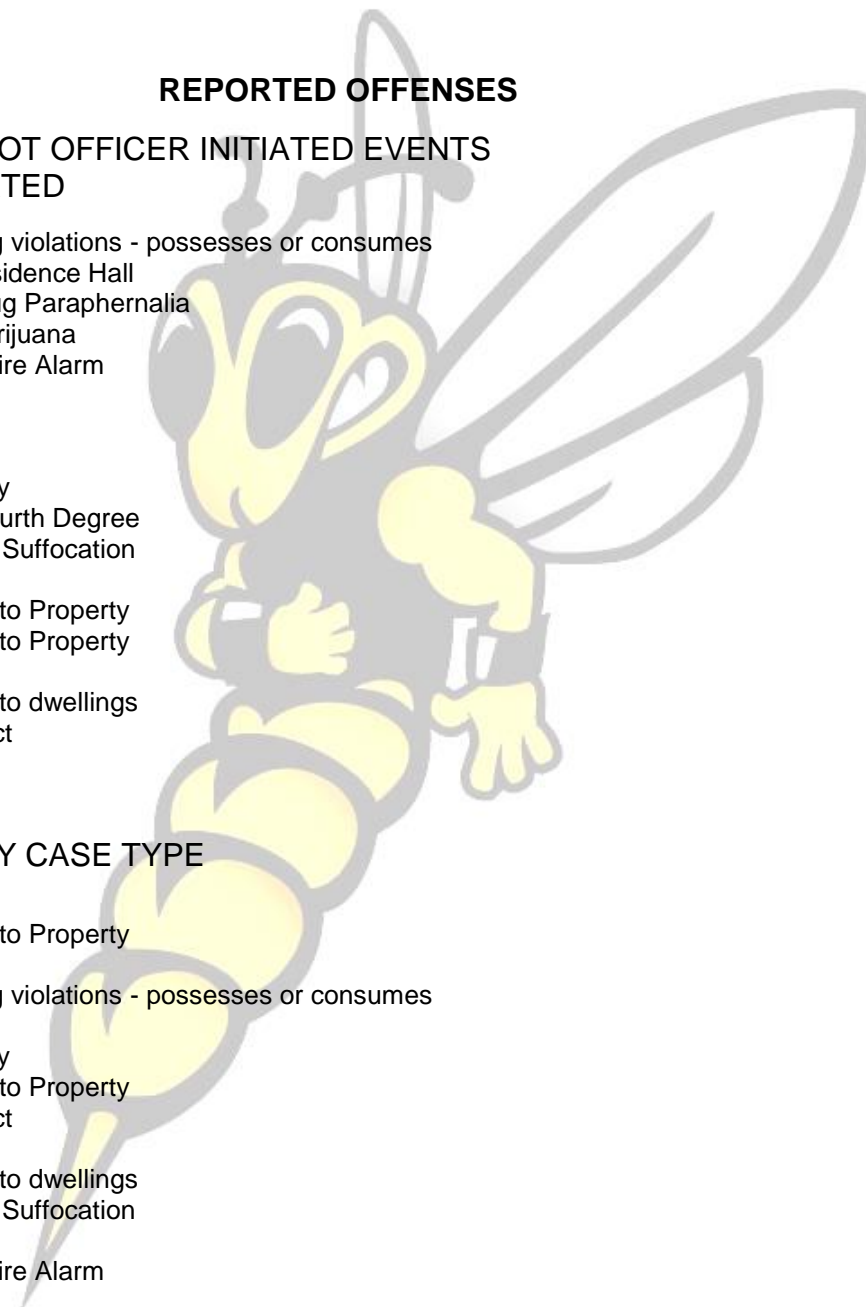

## INCIDENT SUMMARY REPORT October 1 - 31, 2013

- Oct 7<sup>th</sup>:** A female student reported that her passenger side rearview mirror had apparently been stolen off her vehicle while it was parked in lot #6.
- Oct 8<sup>th</sup>:** Campus Safety responded to a report that a vehicle had driven through the construction area on the west side of the Ross/Hawkes Hall link. Witnesses reported that a car had driven onto the sidewalk and knocked down part of a retaining wall and struck a bicycle rack before leaving the area. While conducting the initial investigation it was learned that one of the witnesses, who was visiting Hawkes Hall, had an active warrant for his arrest. He was lodged in the Douglas County Jail by the Superior Police Department who had also received a separate call about the hit and run damage occurring.
- The follow up investigation identified a possible (non-student) suspect and the vehicle was located later in the day at her residence off campus. When interviewed by Campus Safety the vehicle owner admitted to causing the damages but contended it had been an accident as she had lost control while driving. It was discovered there was an active warrant for her arrest and she was also lodged in the Douglas County Jail. This matter remains under investigation pending criminal charges and the determination of restitution.
- Oct 10<sup>th</sup>:** A male student reported that his vehicle that was parked in lot #11 had apparently been keyed.
- Oct 13<sup>th</sup>:** Campus Safety responded to a fire alarm in Hawkes Hall. The activation was determined to have resulted from an intentionally pulled alarm station on the third floor. A male student had been seen near the alarm by another student but he denied actually pulling it. This matter was referred to the Dean of Students and Residence Life Offices for review of any possible internal sanctions. During this event it was also discovered that an exit sign on the 4<sup>th</sup> floor had been vandalized but it could not be determined if this was connected to the alarm being pulled.
- Oct 19<sup>th</sup>:** Campus Safety responded to a report of a possible fight occurring on the second floor of Ostrander Hall. On arrival the officer learned that a non-student male had kicked in a door and fought with two students in the room. The two victims initially downplayed the incident and the suspect was arrested by Superior Police Department officers, who had responded as back-up at the request of the Campus Safety officer, and was lodged in the Douglas County Jail on Disorderly Conduct and Damage to Property charges. One of the students in the room was cited for Underage Drinking.

The follow up investigation determined there was more to this incident. The arrested person was an ex-boyfriend of one of the room occupants. He was able to slip into the building when a student fobbed in at an outside entrance. He proceeded to the room where he kicked in the door after the occupants refused to open the door. The suspect assaulted the two occupants and several items in the room were also damaged. Additional charges of Criminal Trespass, Battery and Substantial Battery were added to the list of charges the suspect faces.

**Oct 24<sup>th</sup>:** Campus Safety received a report that an adult male on a bicycle had patted a female student on the buttocks as he rode past her near N. 19<sup>th</sup> Street and Catlin Avenue. The student did not report this immediately and the suspect could not be located in the area. This information was passed along to the Superior Police Department in the event they may have had similar reports or might know who the person was based on the physical description.

**Oct 25<sup>th</sup>:** A female student reported a suspicious male on a bicycle on campus and requested an escort to her residence just off campus. On the way to her residence she told the officer she believed this same party may have followed her home in the past. She was advised to call the Superior Police Department if she had any contact with this individual off campus. She later did contact them and advised that she had also been patted on the buttocks by this male. The Police Department had apparently received other complaints from non-campus victims and was able to identify a possible suspect. Surveillance on campus was increased over the next couple of days but there were no further sightings or incidents. The Superior Police Department located and arrested the suspect on Monday, 10/28/2013, and charged him with two counts of 4<sup>th</sup> Degree Sexual Assault and Stalking.

**Oct 31<sup>st</sup>:** In Ostrander Hall, a male student was cited for Underage Drinking – first offense, and is subject to a possible fine mount of \$263.50.
