## INCIDENT SUMMARY REPORT October 1 - 31, 2015

<b>Oct 3rd</b>	A call was received reporting an intoxicated male in Curran/McNeill Halls who was subsequently cited for Underage Drinking-first offense, with a possible fine amount of \$263.50.
<b>Oct 10<sup>th</sup></b>	A call was received reporting an intoxicated female in Curran/McNeill Halls who was subsequently cited for Underage Drinking-first offense, with a possible fine amount of \$263.50.
<b>Oct 11<sup>th</sup></b>	A call was received reporting an intoxicated female, a non-resident, in Ostrander Hall who was subsequently cited for Underage Drinking-first offense, with a possible fine amount of \$263.50.
<b>Oct 17<sup>th</sup></b>	While on patrol a Campus Safety Officer found some spray painted vandalism on the track building near 28 <sup>th</sup> Street.
<b>Oct 21<sup>st</sup></b>	A female student reported that her parked vehicle in lot #2 had been the apparent victim of a Hit & Run Accident and received damage around driver's side rear wheel. The complainant said this had occurred on 10/05/2015 sometime between 9:30am and 3:30pm.
<b>Oct 24<sup>th</sup></b>	Officers responded to a report of a possible marijuana odor coming from a room in Curran/McNeill Halls. Contact was made with the female room resident who was subsequently cited for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia and Possession of Marijuana with possible fine amounts of \$326.50 and \$389.50 each.
	A call was received about a cigarette smoke odor in Ostrander Hall. Officers were able to locate the room the odor appeared to be coming from and made contact with the occupants. The investigation resulted in one male resident being cited for Smoking in a Residence Hall and Tampering with Fire Safety Equipment with possible fine amounts of \$200.50 and \$326.50 each. In addition a female resident was cited for Smoking in a Residence Hall with a possible fine amount of \$200.50.
<b>Oct 25<sup>th</sup></b>	While on patrol a Campus Safety Officer observed a male and a female walking toward Curran/McNeill Halls with the male helping the female walk. Upon further investigation the female resident was found to be intoxicated and was cited for Underage Drinking-first offense, with a possible fine amount of \$263.50. The male resident was not cited.
	The SSC Lead Custodian reported that three new-in-the-box J-Fill chemical dispensing units, with a value of \$75.00 each, were missing and presumed stolen from three separate custodial closets in Ross Hall.
<b>Oct 26<sup>th</sup></b>	A Campus Security Authority sent a report to Campus Safety of a possible sexual assault that occurred on campus. The victim did not want a law enforcement investigation and the matter is under further investigation by the Student Conduct Office.
	A Campus Security Authority sent a report to Campus Safety of a possible indecent exposure incident. The victim did not want a law enforcement investigation and the matter is under further investigation by the Student Conduct Office.

<b>Oct 31st</b>	The Superior Police Department responded to a vehicle crash at the intersection of Catlin Avenue and Faxon Street. They found that a vehicle had left the road and crashed into the construction fencing and steam pit rise. The vehicle was unoccupied but it was determined that the owner was a student who resided in Hawkes Hall. Assistance was requested from Campus Safety and the vehicle owner was located and questioned. The owner claimed he not been driving his vehicle and did not know who was. The owner was verbally abusive and uncooperative and was eventually arrested by SPD for Disorderly Conduct.
