INCIDENT SUMMARY REPORT October 1 - 31, 2017

Oct 2nd	A female student reported receiving text and telephone threats from a former boyfriend's mother. The student wished to have this on file in case there are any further contacts.
	Public Safety responded to a report of possible smoking in a room on the 3 rd floor of Curran-McNeill Halls. A male resident of the room was cited for Tampering with Fire Equipment and smoking in the room and is subject to possible fine amounts of \$326.50 and \$200.00 respectively. Two others in the room were also cited for smoking and are subject to a possible fine of \$200.00.
Oct 4th	A student reported via email that about 20 lug nuts having been removed from his vehicle while it was parked in lot #2 on 9/29/2017.
Oct 9th	A female student reported that her vehicle parked in lot #3A had been struck by an unknown vehicle sometime over the previous two days resulting in damage on the driver's side.
Oct 11th	A visitor reported that an unknown vehicle had struck his vehicle in lot #2 while he was attending an event on campus resulting in damage to the left rear quarter panel.
Oct 18th	Public Safety received a report of some money possibly missing from an office in Old Main. The matter remains under investigation.
Oct 26th	An SSC employee found a wallet near Erlanson Hall and turned it in to the Public Safety Office. The wallet contained ID and credit cards but no money. The owner was identified as a student and he was contacted to come in to pick it up. He said there had been \$500 in the wallet when he had lost it two days earlier possibly near Holden Fine Arts.
Oct 28th	A female student reported being sexually assaulted in Crownhart Hall by an individual known to her. The incident is currently under investigation.
Oct 29th	A female student reported her vehicle had been broken into overnight while parked in lot #3B. A window had been broken out to make entry. She said a backpack containing text books was taken.
	While investigating the above report the officer noticed that another vehicle in lot #3B had a broken window and its trunk was open. The officer made contact with the owner, a male student, who was out of town at the time. When he got back on campus he reported the only things missing were a bag of change, the owner's manual and his insurance card.
	A visitor from out of town, who had also been parked in lot #3B overnight, reported his vehicle had been broken into although no windows had been broken out. He reported a set of brand new tools in a box had been stolen. Later in the afternoon the tool box, and two other items that had not been reported missing, were found near the bushes on the south side of Crownhart Hall by Officer Bodin. Arrangements were made to have his friend pick up the tools.
