INCIDENT SUMMARY REPORT
October 1 - 31, 2018

Oct 5th	A student reported that her locked vehicle parked in lot #6 was entered by unknown means and several items of value were stolen from the center console.
Oct 8th	A student reported that someone had entered her unlocked vehicle in lot #12 and stole her wallet.
Oct 10th	A student reported finding some damage on her vehicle parked in lot# 6 from a possible attempt to break into it.
Oct 15th	A student reported the theft of some money from her room in Curran/McNeill Halls.
	A call concerning a suspicious adult white male in the Jim Dan Hill Library was responded to. Upon arrival the male had left the building and could not be located.
Oct 16th	A student reported the theft of some personal belongings from her room in Curran/McNeill Halls.
	Public Safety responded to a possible odor of marijuana on the 4 th floor of Curran/McNeill Halls. A male resident was subsequently cited for Smoking in a Residence Hall and Tampering with Fire Safety Equipment. He is subject to possible fine amounts of \$200.50 and \$326.50 respectively.
Oct 19th	Public Safety responded to a report of a smoke detector going off in a room on the 3 rd floor of Ross hall. No one answered the door so the officer keyed in. No one was present but the officer observed that the smoke detector had been covered with plastic. The room's sole resident was later cited for Tampering with Fire Safety Equipment and is subject to a possible fine amount of \$326.50.
Oct 23rd	Public Safety responded to a report of a suspicious male in the Curran/McNeill Halls. The subject could not be located in the building but was observed a short time later on another part of campus. Assistance was requested from the Superior Police Dept. and contact was made with the party who was found to have a warrant for his arrest. He was lodged in jail by SPD. He claimed he went into the res hall behind someone else who fobbed in and he had only intended to warm up. Officers were unable to find any evidence he had stolen or damaged anything so no charges could be placed on him. He was warned that he would be arrested for trespassing if he was located in a res hall in the future.
Oct 29th	A student reported that her vehicle parked in lot# 6 had been broken into. Nothing was missing but a backpack not belonging to her was left in the car. The owner of the back pack was later located but it is still unclear how it ended up in the car.

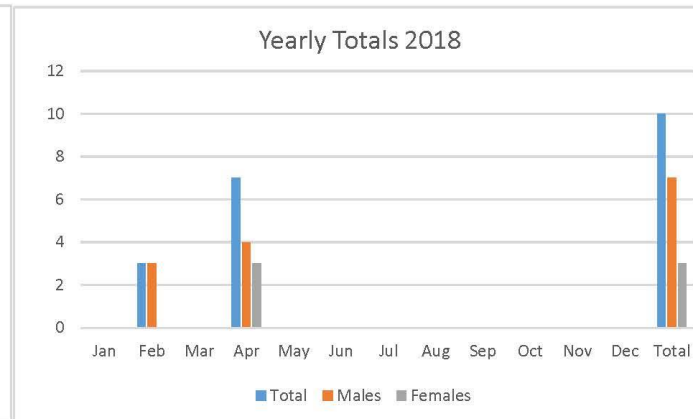
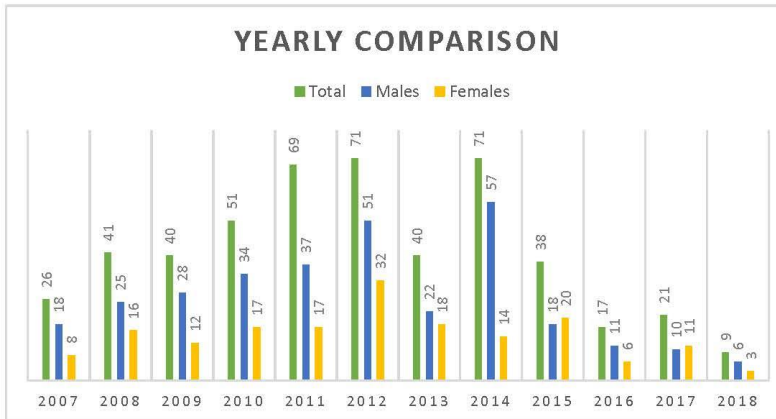
