INCIDENT SUMMARY REPORT September 1 - 30, 2014

Sep 6th	A male student, who had been suspended from campus, was arrested for Trespass to Land when found in one of our buildings. He is subject to a possible fine amount of \$210.00.
Sep 7th	An officer checking on a person lying on the ground at 21 st Street and Catlin Avenue resulted in a female student being cited for Underage Drinking-first offense. She is subject to a possible fine amount of \$263.50.
Sep 10th	Officers responded to check on a report of an unresponsive female in Ostrander Hall. The female was found to have been drinking and she and a male friend were cited for Underage Drinking-first offense, and are each subject to a possible fine amount of \$263.50. The male was arrested a short time later for Disorderly Conduct after acting threatening toward an RA.
Sep 11th	Campus Safety was asked to check on a group of people being loud and possibly drinking in Curran-McNeill Hall. Six males and one female were cited for Underage Drinking-first offense, and are all subject to a possible fine amount of \$263.50.
Sep 13th	Campus Safety responded to a report of loud music being played in a room in Crownhart Hall. Two underage females in the room were found to have been drinking and were cited for Underage Drinking-first offense, and are each subject to a possible fine amount of \$263.50.
	Campus Safety was asked to check on the occupants of a room who were being loud after-hours in Curran-McNeill Hall. Two male residents and one female non-resident were subsequently cited for Underage Drinking-first offense, and are each subject to a possible fine amount of \$263.50. An additional male resident was cited for Underage Drinking-second offense within one year, and faces a possible fine amount of \$389.50.
Sep 15th	A female student reported the overnight theft of her bicycle which had been locked to the bike rack on the south side of Ross Hall.
	Officers responded to a reported odor of possible marijuana on the first floor of Curran-McNeill Hall. They located the room they suspected the odor was emanating from and made contact with the male room occupant. Following their investigation the student was cited for Possession of Marijuana and Drug Paraphernalia. He is subject to possible fine amounts of \$389.50 and \$326.50 respectively.
Sept 18th	A male resident reported the theft of his bicycle which had been locked to the bike rack on the south side of Ross Hall.
	A male student reported that he found damage on the rear of his vehicle and believed it had been struck by a hit and run vehicle while it was parked in Lot #3B.
	Campus Safety received information that a student might have a firearm in his room in Hawkes Hall. Officers investigated and were able to recover an unloaded handgun. The male resident was cited for Possession of a Dangerous Weapon and is subject to a possible fine amount of \$515.50.

Sept 19th	A faculty member reported that a canvas bag containing a laptop computer had been stolen from the back seat of his vehicle while it was parked in Lot #2. He said he thought his vehicle had been locked but there was no sign of forced entry.
	A male resident reported the theft his bicycle which had been locked to the bike rack on the south side of Ross Hall.
Sep 22nd	A faculty member reported that her vehicle had apparently been struck by another vehicle while it was parked in Lot #7. Her vehicle received scrape marks and paint transfer on the left rear corner of its bumper.
Sep 29th	A staff member reported that a set of two (2) small keys had been stolen from underneath her desk.
Sep 30th	A male resident reported the theft of his bicycle which had been locked to the bike rack on the south side of Ross Hall.
