**INCIDENT SUMMARY REPORT
September 1 - 30, 2015**

Sep 4th	An officer responded to a dog complaint.
Sep 6th	While responding to a noise and possible Underage Alcohol complaint in Curran-McNeill Hall's three male residents were cited for Underage Drinking. One was for first offense and is subject to a possible fine amount of \$263.50 and the other two were for second offense and are both subject to a possible fine amount of \$389.50.
	A female student reported that her locked bicycle had been stolen from the south side bike rack of Ross Hall at some time between 9:30pm 09/05 and 1:30am 09/06.
Sep 10th	A female student reported that she had left her wallet in a classroom in Swenson Hall and that it was not there when she returned.
Sep 12th	While responding to a possible vandalism and underage drinking call in Hawkes Hall three males and two females were cited for Underage Drinking - first offense and are all subject to a possible fine amount of \$263.50.
	A female student reported that the driver's side rear tire on her parked vehicle had apparently been slashed.

Sep 16th	A Campus Safety Officer was shown a suspicious package on a manhole cover in lot #5 by a Grounds Crew member. The Superior Police Department was asked to assist with handling the possibility of a bomb. After several hours it was determined that the package was trash dropped there instead of the nearest dumpster by a male student who was later identified and referred to the Dean of Students Office and Chancellor.
	While responding to an underage drinking call in Curran-McNeill Hall's a female was cited for Underage Drinking-first offense. She is subject to a possible fine amount of \$263.50.
Sep 17th	While responding to a noise complaint in Hawkes Hall Two males and one female were cited for Underage Drinking. One male was for second offense and is subject to a possible fine amount of \$389.50 and the other male and female were for first offense and are each subject to a possible fine amount of \$263.50.
Sep 22nd	A report of a male resident in Ross Hall acting in a lewd and lascivious manner was received from a Campus Security Authority.
Sep 23rd	A female student reported that her debit card had been stolen from her unlocked belongings in a female locker room in the Marcovich Wellness Center.
