**INCIDENT SUMMARY REPORT**  
**September 1 - 30, 2018**

<b>Sep 3<sup>rd</sup></b>	Public Safety responded to Curran/McNeill Halls on a report of a strong marijuana odor on the first floor. The officer was able to determine the room it was coming from and made contact with the female resident. She was subsequently cited for Possession of Marijuana and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia which carry possible fine amounts of \$389.50 and \$326.50 respectively.
<b>Sep 6<sup>th</sup></b>	Public Safety was contacted regarding a juvenile male, with a non-campus group using the ropes course, who had been drinking and was in possession of an alcoholic beverage bottle. The Superior Police Dept. was called for assistance and the SPD Officer detained the juvenile until a relative could come and pick him up.
<b>Sep 7<sup>th</sup></b>	A report was received of a damaged soap dispenser in the second floor rest room of Crownhart Hall.
<b>Sep 14<sup>th</sup></b>	A report of the possible fraudulent use of a credit card was reported to Campus Safety as well as the Superior Police Department. The matter is under investigation.
<b>Sep 21<sup>st</sup></b>	A student reported that someone had keyed his car. He said it could have occurred in either lot# 5 or at Walmart.
<b>Sep 25<sup>th</sup></b>	Public Safety responded to lot #7 on a report of an intoxicated female who looked like she might need some type of help. When the officer arrived the female was found to be with a friend who said he would take care of her. The officer determined she was not in need of any assistance.

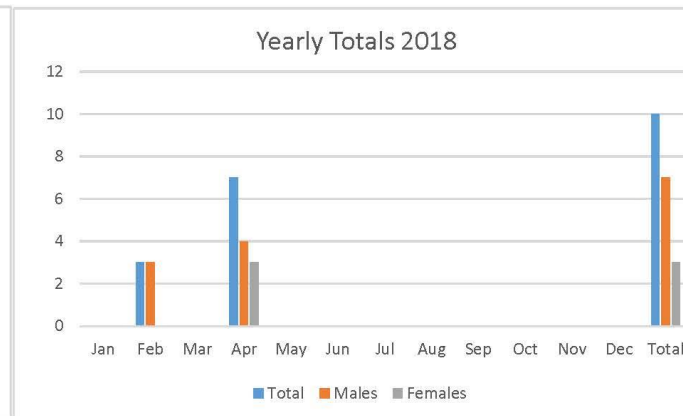
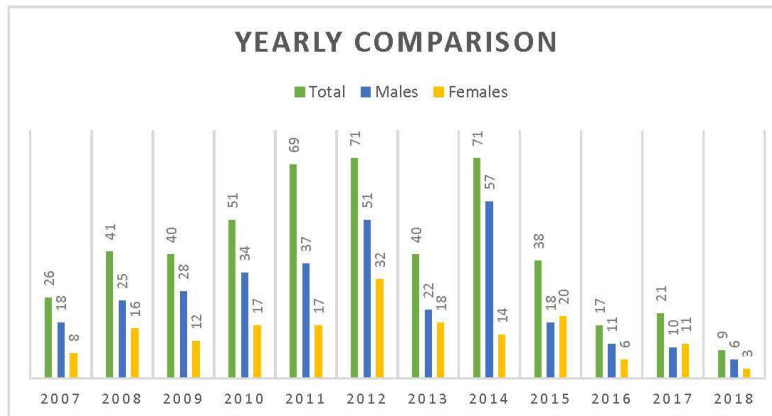
