INCIDENT SUMMARY REPORT
November 1 - 30, 2018

Nov 10th	While responding to a call of a female “passed out” in the Yellowjacket Union, one female student was cited for Underage Drinking – first offense, and is subject to a possible fine amount of \$263.50.
Nov 16th	A report of a vehicle vandalized with raw eggs in lot #2 was taken. Upon further investigation another vehicle was noted to have been egged as well. The vehicles were parked in the Enterprise Rental Vehicle overnight parking area of lot #2. A student reported that her cell phone had apparently been stolen from the 1 st floor women’s rest room in Swenson Hall where she had left it for a few minutes, and found it missing when she went back to look for it.
Nov 20th	While responding to an odor of marijuana coming from the 4 th floor of Curran/McNeill Halls, a female resident was cited for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia and is subject to a possible fine amount of \$326.50.
Nov 27th	A student reported that someone had hit the front of his parked vehicle in lot #3A and did not leave any contact information. (Hit & Run to a parked vehicle) While responding to a noise complaint and a possible Underage Drinking call in Hawkes Hall, a female resident was cited for Underage Possession of Alcohol and is subject to a possible fine amount of \$263.50.

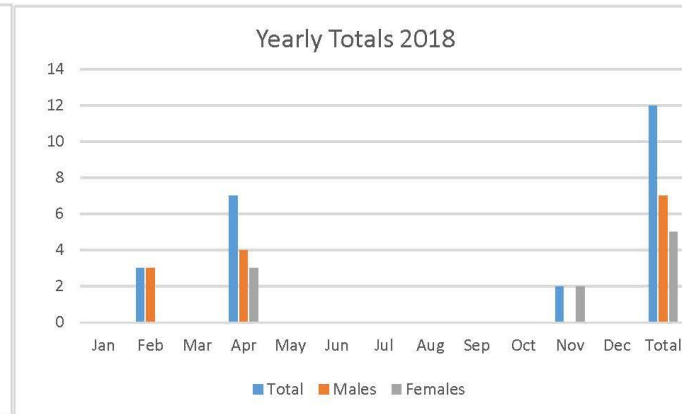
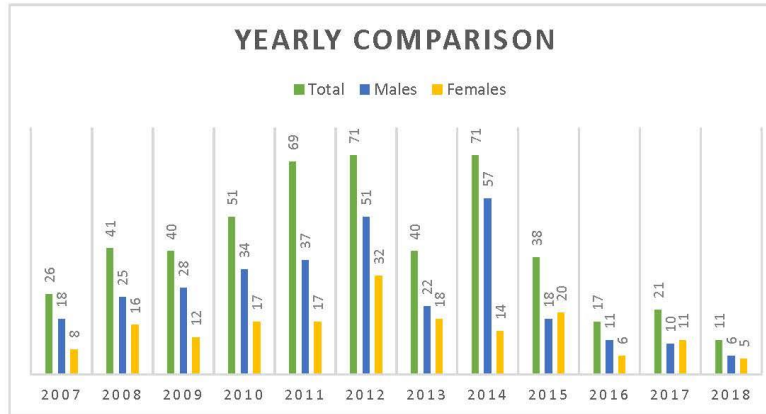
