-Campus Safety Walk: Annually, the Chancellor does a safety walk around campus to be more proactive on ensuring students' safety. This year, we would like to see more students walk alongside our chancellor. The tentative date for this walk will be October 29th, 2014 at 6:30pm. We are going to set it at this time so the majority of SGA can attend. There has been no location picked for where we would all meet at this time, but we will be updated soon.
