

**CALL FOR APPLICATIONS**  
**UW System Symposium for Undergraduate Research and Creative Activity**  
**Stevens Point, WI**  
**April 21, 2016**

The UW-Superior Center for Undergraduate Research, Scholarship, and Creative Activity (URSCA) invites interested students to submit applications to present scholarly work at the UW-System Symposium for Undergraduate Research and Creative Activity at UW – Stevens Point. The Symposium includes poster sessions, oral presentations, and performing and visual art presentations. Oral presentations are 15 minutes (with 5 additional minutes for questions).

Up to 10 students will be selected to represent UW-Superior at this event. Students selected for this opportunity will be expected to have a presentation poster (if presenting a poster) prepared by March 17, and should plan to commit both April 20 and 21 to travel and attendance at the event. Poster printing and travel will be coordinated and paid for by URSCA.

**APPLICATION PROCESS:**

- Submit an application, signed by your mentor or faculty sponsor, to [ursca@uwsuper.edu](mailto:ursca@uwsuper.edu)

- Applications are due to the URSCA office by **February 10, 2017**

Applications should include the following information:

- 1) Title of project;
- 2) Student name, e-mail address, and phone number;
- 3) Faculty/staff mentor name;
- 4) A 200 word abstract that describes the student's research, scholarly or creative work clearly and concisely for an audience outside of the field of study. Use the Guide for Abstract Preparation available on the URSCA website.
- 5) A paragraph that describes the significance of the research or creative work and states why the student wants to present at the Symposium and what he/she hopes to gain from the experience. Students collaborating on a project should submit one abstract, but each student should write his or her own second paragraph. All parts of a group application should be submitted together.

**SELECTION PROCESS:**

Applications will be reviewed by the URSCA director and members of the URSCA committee. Projects will be selected based upon quality of student work, the student's statement, and completeness of the application.

- Applications are due to URSCA by **February 10, 2017**
