YOUR GUIDE TO LIVING ON-CAMPUS AT UW-SUPERIOR

LOOKING TO APPLY FOR HOUSING?
CHECK OUT THE HELPFUL TIPS BELOW
TO BEGIN THE HOUSING CONTRACT
PROCESS FOR UWS.

Log into your Live@UWS account. You will submit your housing contract using the [Live@UWS](#) website that can be found on the ResLife homepage or by using the search bar on the UW-Superior homepage. You will log in as a 'Resident' with the username and password that you created using the UW-Superior login portal.

Complete your housing contract. After logging in, you will create a new student housing contract by selecting the academic year you will be living on-campus. In the contract, you will also select:

- Your [meal plan choice](#) (Black & Gold or Superior Plan)
- Housing preferences (Single/Double Room, Residence Hall, Living Community)

Your housing contract will be approved within 1 to 2 business days of submission. You will receive an automated approval email to your UW-Superior email address. After your housing contract is approved, you can begin to search for a roommate, if you are looking to room with another student.

Start your roommate search. View other students' profiles by clicking on the "Roommate " tab of your Live@UWS homepage.

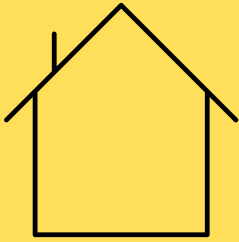
Confirm a roommate selection. To confirm a roommate, a roommate group will need to be created from the "Roommate" tab. One student will be the "group leader" and form a roommate group by entering their roommate code (located in upper right-hand portion of the Live@UWS profile screen) and sending a roommate group invite. The other student will simply hit accept and you have formed a roommate group! If you have done this step, you will be roommates. You won't receive a roommate confirmation from the Residence Life Office for this step.

Please note: New freshmen students can select a roommate but will be placed into a room by the Residence Life Office based on living community selection, hall preference, and roommate selection. To live in a living community, both roommates must take part in the program.

Room placements will be completed by mid to late June. If students wish to form a roommate group, it should be done so before this time. You won't receive a room confirmation from the Residence Life Office. You will see your room and hall in your Live@UWS account by mid to late June.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What are on-campus living requirements? Freshmen and sophomore students (students who have 56 credits or less) who are not veterans, married or living with parents or guardian and who have not reached the age of 20 by the first day of classes of fall semester are required to live on campus. Students who live with a guardian less than 35 miles away from campus may be considered a Commuter and live off campus. This is a UW System policy.

Do the Residence Halls have wireless Internet connection? Yes! We are proud of our wireless system accessible in all residence halls.

What is my username/password for Live@UWS? You will use the username and password that you created using the UW-Superior login portal to access Live@UWS.

What Residence Hall will I live in as a new freshman student? New freshman students live in Curran-McNeil or Ostrander Halls. View hall floor plans from the 'Housing Resources' page below.

What living communities are available to new freshman students?

- Campus Recreation/Adventure
- Creative Arts

How do I choose a roommate? Log into [Live@UWS](#) and go under the Roommates tab. You will see a drop down box where you will select the term in which you are looking for a roommate. After choosing the term, the site will load a new page where it will list different profiles that are still looking for roommates. You can either look through that list, or change the search filters to narrow your search down by clicking on the "Change Search Filters" button. Once you find a profile you would like to room with, you must acquire their roommate code. Then go under the "Find Someone You Know" tab and enter their roommate code to send an invite to them to become a roommate pair. Both roommates must enter their own roommate codes.

Do I have to finish my contract in Live@UWS before I find a roommate? Yes. Until your contract is completed, submitted and approved no further steps can be taken in housing.

Can I choose my roommate/room right away after submitting my application?

No, you have to wait for Residence Life to approve your application before you can proceed. This process should occur within 24 business hours of you submitting your contract. Note: if you submit your contract on a Saturday or Sunday your contract will be approved on Monday.

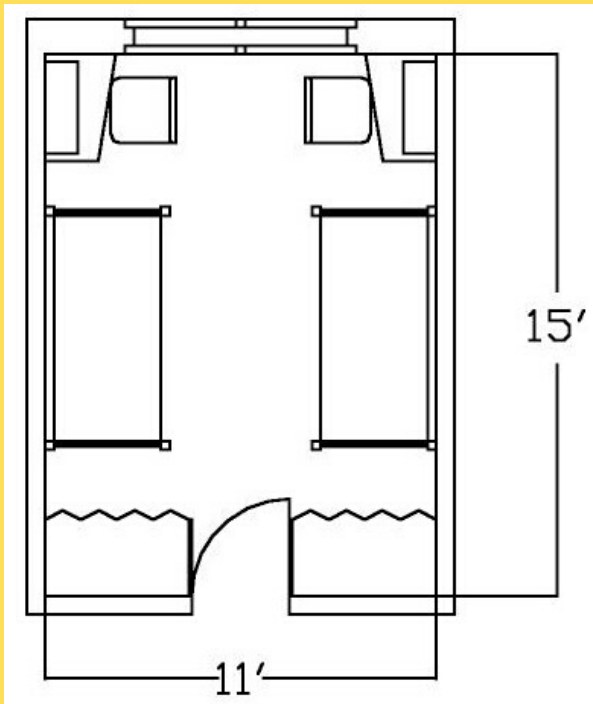
What do I do if I want a double room, but no one is matching with me? That is OK. New students have until July to search for and select a roommate. After this date, Residence Life will then pair people up and place them in rooms accordingly. So after that date you will be matched with someone else and assigned your room.

How do I update my information for Live@UWS or make changes to my housing contract? Email Residence Life at reslife@uwsuper.edu with the changes you would like to be made and they will be able to change the information in your contract on Live@UWS.
