INTRODUCE YOURSELF

- Prepare an introduction (also called an 'elevator pitch') to share who you are,
 where you are in your career path, where you're headed and how you are unique.
- It's important to create an introduction for yourself you never know when you'll meet someone who could help you in your future professional life



1 SHARE WHO YOU ARE

- Name
- Major or Intended Field of Study
 - o k to share that you're still exploring
- Professional Credentials

2 SHARE YOUR GOAL OR CAREER DIRECTION

- Let them know the position you'd ideally like to have someday
- Once I graduate, my plan is to...
- I'm currently working toward....
- 3 MAKES YOU UNIQUE
- Share your talent, skills, experiences, leadership
- How you could fit into their organization, problems you'd like to help solve, etc.

4 WITH A OUESTION

- Ask a question or if they know anyone who you should connect with next
- Ask how to stay connected for future opportunities
