PROGRAM SUMMARY • OCTOBER 1999 - FEBRUARY 2018



Students served are **low income and first generation** (neither parent has a Bachelor's degree) or are from a **group that is underrepresented in graduate school** (African American, Native American, or Hispanic).

Students complete an intensive summer research program, Graduate Record Examination preparation and graduate school admissions preparation. Student's research is published in *The McNair Scholars Journal of the University of Wisconsin-Superior*
