



ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

**For transfer of credits between
The University of Wisconsin-Superior Bachelor of Science in Nursing
And Northwood Technical College Associate of Applied Science Degree**

Effective Dates: June 2025-2027

Review Date: March 2027

Introduction and Rationale:

The University of Wisconsin-Superior maintains an educational partnership with Northwood Technical College (Northwood Tech) to provide opportunities for students to enter bachelor's degree completion programs. In the interest of fostering cooperation between our institutions, and to better serve the transfer of students from Northwood Tech to the University of Wisconsin-Superior, the faculty and administration of our institutions have established this articulation agreement in conjunction with the articulation agreement between the Universities of Wisconsin System and Northwood Tech for the BSN@HOME state collaborative program for RNs.

This agreement specifies the transfer of credit from the Northwood Tech Nursing AAS degree named above to the UW-S Bachelor's Degree named above in recognition that the Nursing AAS program prepares students for admission to this Bachelor's degree program. The underlying assumption for this agreement is that the Technical College provides a foundation of coursework, and the University provides the upper-level courses required within the Bachelor's degree program.

Northwood Tech students who complete the Nursing Associate degree above and wish to transfer to the University of Wisconsin-Superior will be awarded 30 Nursing program credits. The following transfer courses and remaining University Studies, Electives, and Nursing courses will provide the necessary credits for a Bachelor of Science in Nursing Degree.

* Additional elective credits taken may not be eligible for financial aid at Northwood Tech. Work with your advisor to determine eligibility.

Requirements and Considerations:

Students from Northwood Tech must have completed the above-named program with a transfer grade point average of at least 2.5 on a 4-point scale for consideration for transfer under the terms of this document and the BSN@HOME UW System Collaborative articulation agreement.

Northwood Tech general education /breadth courses in communication, social sciences, mathematics, and natural science may transfer to fulfill UW-Superior university studies requirements in these areas. All UW-Superior university studies core and knowledge category requirements not met by transfer credits must be completed to meet graduation requirements.

A minimum of 30 nursing credits from the program named above will be transferred in as listed above and counted towards the Nursing degree (BSN) per BSN@HOME UW System Collaborative articulation agreement.

Other credits from Northwood Tech may transfer in as credits toward graduation but may not fit into the Nursing degree.

Elective courses taken at Northwood Tech that are not listed in the agreement will be reviewed by UW-Superior faculty in the degree program named above on a case-by-case basis.

- Sixty (60) credits in nursing and credits in university studies, electives, and non-nursing courses are required for a total of 120 credits to complete the bachelor's degree named above.
- A minimum of 30 credits must be earned at UW-Superior to be awarded any degree from this institution.
- The last 12 credits must be taken at UW-Superior.
- At least 36 credits in upper-division courses (300-400)

To be eligible for the bachelor's degree named above, students must maintain a 2.3/4.0 grade point average in upper-division courses.

Students are required to complete a final internship and senior research project to fulfill graduation requirement for the bachelor's degree named above

Conditions:

The terms of this articulation agreement apply only for the purposes of entry to the Bachelor of Science Nursing Degree at the University of Wisconsin-Superior. Northwood Tech students seeking admission to other degree programs offered at UW-Superior may transfer to the University only those credits recognized under the current transfer guidelines as documented on the TES/Transferology website at tes.collegesource.com.

This agreement is limited to the University requirements for completion of a Bachelor's degree only. Students seeking certification for licensure in particular fields must complete any additional requirements for such certification.
